



Mindfulpaws Doggy Daycare: Pre-requisites to Group Play

Welcome to Mindfulpaws Doggy Daycare! To ensure a safe, enjoyable experience for every dog, we have a few key pre-requisites that all pups must meet before joining group play sessions. These guidelines help us maintain a positive environment where dogs can socialize, play, and thrive.

1. Vaccination Requirements

- All dogs must be up-to-date on vaccinations, including core vaccines such as distemper, parvovirus..
- A current kennel cough vaccination is also required.
- Proof of vaccination is required upon registration and must be kept updated.

2. Health and Wellness

- Dogs must be in good health and free from contagious conditions, such as kennel cough, parasites, or skin infections.
- Dogs recovering from surgery or injury may require a clearance note from a veterinarian before rejoining group play.
- If your dog has a chronic health condition, please inform our staff so we can monitor and accommodate their needs.

3. Behavioral Suitability

- Dogs should display friendly, non-aggressive behavior towards other dogs and people.
- Any history of aggression, resource guarding, or severe anxiety must be disclosed.
- Our trained team assesses each dog's temperament to ensure compatibility with group play.



4. Age and Maturity

- Puppies are welcome to join once they are fully vaccinated (usually around 16 weeks).
- Dogs of all ages can join, but puppies and senior dogs will be placed in suitable groups that match their energy levels and needs.

5. Spaying and Neutering

- Dogs older than nine months must be spayed or neutered to participate in group play.
- If your dog is intact due to medical reasons, please discuss with us to determine if they are a good fit for group play.

6. Registration and Documentation

- Each dog must be registered with Mindfulpaws Doggy Daycare, including completing our information form that details your dog's behavior, health, and personality.
- Agreeing to our terms and conditions is required to attend Mindfulpaws..

7. Socialization Skills

- Dogs with prior socialization experience in dog parks, classes, or other group settings are best suited for group play.
- We recommend basic obedience skills, such as responding to "sit," "stay," and "recall" commands, to support a safe and manageable group environment.

8. Owner Contact Information

- We require accurate and up-to-date contact details in case we need to reach you while your dog is with us.
- Please notify us of any changes in your dog's health, behavior, or routines.
